

Construction Activity Notice Overnight Work September 8th through 11th

Overnight bridge beam removal begins Monday, September 8th at 9PM and continues during overnight hours through Thursday, September 11th at 5AM.

This work must take place overnight because the I-94 lane closures and traffic stops needed to complete this work are only allowed at night. This work will generate noise at the Old Orchard Road interchange with I-94.

Expect minor delays on Old Orchard Road as flaggers direct truck traffic. Expect overnight ramp closure and lane closures on I-94 in both directions. Expect short full closures of I-94 as each beam section is lifted off of the old structure.

Expected Work Activities:

- Truck and Crane Traffic
[expect louder engine noises and the beeping of backup and operational alarms]
- Beam Removal
[this includes steel torching/cutting and securing beams to trailers for hauloff]
- Traffic Control
[this includes warning horns and sirens as the Illinois State Police and IDOT Minutemen stop traffic]
